## Regulations on the Handling of Result Re-Appealing by Faculty Review Committee, College of Liberal Arts, National Cheng Kung University

Approved by the College Council Meeting on Nov. 13<sup>th</sup>, 1997.

Amended and approved by the College Council Meeting on June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2007.

Amended and approved by the College Council Meeting on October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2007.

- I. In order to protect the rights and interests of faculty members in various matters reviewed by the Faculty Review Committee of the Department (Institute), the Faculty Review Committee of the College (hereinafter referred to as the Committee) has specified the regulations for the handling of results re-appealing in the Faculty Review Committee (hereinafter referred to as the regulations).
- II. If a faculty member of NCKU have doubts over any results made by the Department (Institute) of the Faculty Review Committee, he or she may file for a re-appeal on the results made by the Faculty Review Committee within one week after receiving the decision made by the Department (Institute) Faculty Review Committee with a written submission to the Committee. Re-appealing over a decision is limited to once.
- III. The Dean of the College of Liberal Arts serves as the convener of the committee. After receiving the written re-appeal, six members of the Committee (including the Dean) will be appointed to form a special taskforce to handle the case. When the Dean is unable to convene and preside over the meeting due to some reason or recusal, the selection of the acting chairperson and taskforce members shall be nominated by the faculty review committee of the College.
- IV. The taskforce shall give the re-appealing faculty members the opportunity to fully explain the reasons for their rebuttal. If at least five members of the taskforce agree with the reasons for the re-appeal, the reviewing record, together with relevant information of the applicant, shall be sent to the Committee for reconsideration; If no more than five agree, the taskforce would decline the re-appeal. In that case, the reviewing record and relevant information are sent to the Committee for reviewing and discussion, then dealt with it according to appropriate procedures.

These regulations have been implemented after being approved by the V. College Council Meeting. The same applies when it is amended.
